

## Summative Peer Evaluation Processes

Summative peer evaluation is formal feedback an evaluator shares with the review committee, who makes recommendations to the vice dean for the purpose of deciding merit, promotion, tenure, or continuing appointment. Summative evaluation occurs after an evaluation tool has been distributed to all faculty who will be evaluated with it, and after evaluators have been trained in its use. If using CET evaluation tools, CET can provide training sessions. If a school creates its own tools, it will need to develop and deliver its own training sessions.
